They spent hours redesigning the floor plan in unfamiliar buildings, entering new information on the website to include class schedules and payment methods, and securing instructors willing to return to rings in these bizarre times.

By all reports, everything ran perfectly. Thank you again Liz, Chuck and Cheri.

That was the good news; and, now for the bad news: The Board of Directors has made the decision to cancel the GABOC Obedience Trial scheduled Saturday, October 31 and Sunday, November 1. Treasurer, Donna Eichman, did a cost analysis listing our estimated income vs. expenses and presented her concerns to the Board. Even if we could guarantee 75% of the 2019 entries, we would lose approximately \$3,500. As you know, there is no way to guarantee the entry numbers. The Board agreed that we could not justify such an incredible loss; and, with regret voted to cancel. The following are Donnas' findings. What not to eat!


Make sure you keep your dog or puppy healthy and happy by avoiding these FORBIDDEN foods:

- Chocolate
- Grapes and raisins
- Onions
- Garlic
- Nuts and seeds
- Very fatty foods
- · Cooked bones
- Caffeine

- Rhubarb
- Salt
- Xylitol (sugar substitute)













Get your pet in the picture-taking mood with a few treats. Then snap away, holding more treats in your hand near the camera, so your model will look your way.

SNEAK ATTACK

Come up on your pet quietly with your camera ready to go. Call out softly at the last moment if you want a nose-on shot.



NATURAL LIGHT

Whenever possible, avoid using a flash to take photos of your pet.

An Example: Boogie Recall & The Four Quadrants

















ADD Good Stuff Behavior is encouraged (if most of the time, he gets a YES! and treat.)

Positive Reinforcement







Negative Punishment

STOP Good Stuff Behavior is discouraged (if most of the time, he has to stop doing something fun)





Positive Punishment

ADD Bad Stuff Behavior is discouraged (if most of the time, I bring out the dreaded ear wash bottle.)








Negative Reinforcement

STOP Bad Stuff Behavior is encouraged (if most of the time, he gets relief from social pressure)

The Young Person's Guide To

WOOFS and GROWLS

Dogs are different to people. Clarissa will show us what to do - and what not to do around dogs.



Never put your face near a dog's face.





Be quiet and walk slowly. Dogs gets scared of loud noises and fast movement.



Always wait for a dog to come to you. If they want to be stroked or play, they will ask!



Never disturb dogs when they are sleeping.




Never go up to or touch a dog you don't know.

Never go up to a dog when they are eating.




Dogs growl when they are angry or scared.

Fold your arms and walk away slowly.









How to Socialize Your Dog?



Positive socialization is an important aspect of caring for your pet dog. Take him to explore new places and meet other people and animals and reward him for every successful interaction.

Socializing with New People

Introduce one person at a time, starting with family



Consider dog





Have the people he's meeting offer him treats or his favorite



Take him to the pet store with you when you go buy supplies.

Socializing with Other Animals

Train him to pay attention to you in a distration-free environment.













Allow him to watch animals from a safe distance first.



Don't push if he hesitates or barks. Try again thenext day.

New Things and Environments

Let your dog walk on grass, cement, and different surfaces.



Take your dog to see bodies of water.



Take him to the park.





Remember: Follow your dog's cue!

If he seems to be having a good time, then you've done a good job training your dog how to socialize! However, it's also possible he won't seem comfortable, get overexcited, or appear shy or fearful on the first tries. Be patient even if your dog's progress is slow.
