

So, I was asked to write a little bit about how I started with Glenbard and what I do with my dogs. Well, here it goes...

My first experience with Glenbard All Breed Obedience Club was many years ago around 1986 when my family got our first puppy. It was a Chesapeake Bay Retriever named Coco. I was pregnant at the time with my third and last daughter, so my husband brought her to puppy and then beginner classes. Our instructor was Esther Purtriskis. Little did I know that I would come to know Esther very well years later as a member of the Medallion Rottweiler Club. Coco loved it and did very well. She loved to work. Had I known then what I know now, I would have continued and shown her in obedience as she would have done very well. She was a family pet and spoiled rotten but never competed in obedience.

Fast Forward a little over 10 years while I was training and trialing my first rottweiler Xena, I would come to the correction matches at Glenbard. They were very crowded back then as were all the trials.

We then moved up to Dave's Novice II class. She did very well and enjoyed the attention.




About 6 months old here.

While I started his training at a facility closer to home for his first two puppy classes, I then started private lessons with Dave Parison. Since he was an instructor at Glenbard as well, he encouraged me to bring Flynn for additional training in the Novice II class on Monday nights. So, we started training on Monday nights as well. Occasionally I would help by filling in for instructors. Then sadly when Lynn Weis got sick she asked me if I would take over the Utility run-thrus at 8:15 and lock up the building. I did that, and I still do so every week. Flynn's obedience career has gone very well with the help and guidance of my trainer Dave Parison as well as help and tips I've received from various Glenbard members.

Besides obedience, I have been involved with tracking. I started with my first rottweiler Xena and have tracked with every rottweiler since. Xena was a natural tracker from the age of 12 weeks. She went on to become a Champion Tracker at the age of 10.5 years! I also earned tracking titles on my next rottweiler, Rebel. He earned his TD and TDX, but I lost him before he earned his VST title. I also tracked with my rescue Roxie although she never earned any titles, it was great for boosting her confidence.

I continue to track with my current dogs, Flynn and Teagan. They are doing very well and will be ready soon to be certified so they can enter their first tracking test.

My newest activity that I am doing with my dogs is Carting! It's so much fun! I started by converting a bike trailer into a cart for Flynn to pull last fall. Then as I started to look online at companies that make and sell carts for quite a bit of money, I thought, I can make that! So, I made a couple different carts. I made my first one lighter and smaller for training for both Flynn and Teagan. Since Teagan is now over a year old she has started carting with the smaller and lighter cart and she loves it!

Here are some pictures of them with the carts. Medallion Rottweiler Club has a carting test this October that they are entered in. Wish us luck! We are doing lots of long walks pulling the carts for practice.






BRAGS





AWARDS REQUIREMENTS

Members who choose to receive an award paid for by the club may do so by <u>fulfilling and documenting the requirements</u> on the awards form (available on the club website or at the club) for the year in which the title was earned. Special circumstances, such as contributing to the club by doing activities not listed in the requirements, will not exempt members from completing all requirements.



The following requirements must be met:

MEETINGS

Six general membership meetings are held before board meetings, in February, April, June, August, October, and November. You must attend a general membership or board meeting in two different months. Dates and locations will be announced.

MONDAY NIGHT TRAINING and/or SUNDAY TRACKING SESSIONS

You must train at least twelve Mondays at the GABOC facility, or participate in twelve regular Sunday tracking sessions, or any combination totaling twelve.

TRIALS

You must work a total of four hours at GABOC trials. These hours can be served at our obedience trials, agility trials, tracking tests, or any combination of trials/tests, as long as the accumulated total is four hours. Your service can be to steward, set up, take down, etc., or perform any other duty required to help run the event.

ELECTIVE REQUIREMENT

In addition to the Meetings, Training/Tracking, and Trials requirements, you must also complete one of the following options:

Matches: Serve as a steward or judge at one match without accepting payment.

Committees/Projects: Chair or serve on a club committee or club project.

Additional Training: Train an additional six Monday nights and/or Sunday tracking sessions.

Board members, club officers, instructors, and table helpers are exempt from the elective requirement




